Celebrating Ukrainian Culture and Heritage Through The Power of Music

Winnipeg-based community Television and Radio broadcaster U Multicultural empowers youth to celebrate and showcase their cultural heritage with music.

Ukrainian Music for Kids is a piano performance project organized by U Multicultural in partnership with Winnipeg Arts Gallery and Steinbach Arts Council and funded by the Government of Manitoba. The series is a collection of video mini-concerts featuring ten youths aged 10-17 years old with diverse backgrounds performing piano music written by Ukrainian composers. This special initiative is aimed at supporting kids in learning music and piano techniques and performing music written by composers of Ukrainian heritage.

Music practice classes were led by Victoria Tuz, who graduated from the Music Academy in Ukraine and worked in the same Academy for many years, continuing to teach after she moved to Canada in 2009. Thanks to her efforts, the youth were excited to perform on stage for all to see. These performances will be broadcast across Manitoba through TV cable and online.

"I'm really excited to take part in this interesting project. It was such a joy to research all the amazing pieces of Ukrainian composers," says Tuz.
